

## TAMPA RADIO-CONTROL AIRCRAFT CLUB

The **Tampa Radio-control Aircraft Club (TRAC)** is a Chartered Club Member of the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA). TRAC promotes radio-control model aviation, including all its various aspects. Our members enjoy flying sport, aerobatic, and giant-scale airplanes, helicopters, gliders, scale-airplane replicas, electric-powered airplanes, and any other type of aircraft supported by model aviation.

Since the club is chartered by the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA), members of TRAC are required to join the AMA. Membership in AMA offers many benefits, including liability insurance in the event of an accident. As a member of TRAC, you will be introduced to other pilots already proficient in this sport and through them you can enjoy the camaraderie of other enthusiasts. If you're just getting started, TRAC has qualified instructors to help you select the appropriate aircraft and equipment, and provide free flight instruction. Local hobby shops can also advise you about the appropriate aircraft and equipment you need to get started.

TRAC conducts various events throughout the year. Club members are encouraged to fly in the events or help with them, or both. These events raise funds for the club to maintain the flying site. We also hold fly-ins to collect donations for a local charity.

The TRAC Field is located off Interstate 4 (Exit 10) at 7208 N. Taylor Rd., Seffner, FL. (See directions on the reverse side of this paper). The flying site has a 46'  $\times$  400' paved runway, a 50'  $\times$  400' grass runway, protected pilot boxes, and a covered shelter. The gate to the field is locked except when club members are flying.

Weather permitting, we fly regularly on many weekdays, and on Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 a.m. until dark. If the gate is open, please feel free to come in and check out the flying site, visit with the members, watch the flying activities, and ask questions.

TRAC monthly meetings are held at the flying field on the second Saturday of each month at 11:00 a.m. Visitors are welcome. If you would like more information about TRAC, please contact any of the Club officers listed below or visit our Web site:
